Dear Residents, Families and Powers of Attorneys:

Today we have had a staff member from 2<sup>nd</sup> floor skilled test positive for Covid-19. All 2nd floor residents were tested using both a quick test(all negative); as well as a swab lab test(results by Thursday).

This staff member is off according to the guidance given by CDC and our Walworth County Health department.

Residents on 2nd floor will wear masks when in public spaces.

Visits to 2<sup>nd</sup> floor will be limited to approved essential visits and compassionate visits.

In-house spousal visits on the floor will be suspended at this time.

Activities on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor will be limited.

Guests coming into the building must answer the health survey, have temperature taken, mask when here for an approved essential or compassionate visit.

All residents, when outside of their room, are required to use a mask. Transportation for medical appointments will continue. Window visits for 2<sup>nd</sup> floor are available. Beauty Shop services will be suspended for 2<sup>nd</sup> floor at this time.

Residents in apartments will continue to wear masks when out in common areas of the building. There are no changes in activities for 4<sup>th</sup> floor, apartments, or Hearthstone.

We continue to be in contact with the Public Health Department in Walworth County, our Medical Director, as well as monitor and follow our Public Health and CDC guidelines.
