NOTICE/UPDATE from Fairhaven

To Residents Families Friends and Responsible Parties,

Today we have had a staff member on skilled nursing 2nd floor test positive. This person is now off for the prescribed time set by DHS, CMS and local Public Health.

We are currently in the process of testing staff on 2nd floor and will continue to monitor all staff as they arrive for work and will continue to do so. We are also in the process of testing the 17 residents on 2nd floor and will continue to monitor for signs and symptoms.

Rapid tests were done on residents and staff on the 2nd floor today, and all were negative.

To Visitors, PLEASE if you have been exposed to someone with covid, having any symptoms or awaiting test results, **postpone your visit**, (unless compassion, palliative, or hospice visit).

All visitors, staff and contractors need to enter and exit through the main entrance so appropriate monitoring takes place; temperature check, exposure questions and **surgical mask(required)**.

Be considerate, do not take the chance of exposing your family member or the Fairhaven Community. Visiting after being exposed places everyone at risk and will limit our ability to serve or care for those exposed. We do not want to go into outbreak mode as that will place a huge strain on our limited staffing availability.

For apartments residents if you have been exposed, please remain in your apartment, and contact the front desk so staff may follow up. Monitor yourself for any symptoms over the following days and limit your visiting.

All residents should wear a surgical mask when in the halls, common areas or participating in any activities. Apartments residents with guests, if you do not know the vaccinations status a mask should be worn during the visit.
