**COVID NOTICE.....This is critical!**

With the holiday, we have had multiple vaccinated staff members test positive (who fortunately were not in our building recently) and are now off work for 10 days. We have had multiple residents who have been exposed to family or friends who are positive, and we are monitoring. Cases of influenza have also been reported and are on the increase.

**To Visitors, PLEASE** if you have been exposed to someone with covid, having any symptoms or awaiting test results, **postpone your visit**, (unless compassion, palliative, or hospice visit).

**Be considerate, do not take the chance of exposing your family member or the Fairhaven Community.** Visiting after being exposed places everyone at risk and will limit our ability to serve or care for those exposed. We do not want to go into outbreak mode as that will place a huge strain on our limited staffing availability. We have been fortunate to have staffing match our current census of 15 – licensed capacity is 82.

**For Apartment residents** if you have been exposed, please remain in your apartment, and contact the front desk so staff may follow up. Monitor yourself for any symptoms over the following days and limit your visiting.

**All visitors, staff and contractors need to enter, and exit from the main entrance** so appropriate monitoring takes place; temperature check, exposure questions and surgical mask(required).

**All residents should wear a surgical mask when in the halls, common areas or participating in any activities.**
